Comcast Corporation (“Comcast”) hereby submits a supplemental response to question III.J of the Commission’s December 5, 2005 Information and Document Request (“Request”).¹ Because the documents provided are highly proprietary and are maintained in the strictest of confidence by Comcast, Comcast submits them pursuant to the Second Protective Order in the docket.²
