Dear Madam Secretary:

AT&T Inc, on behalf of its affiliate, SBC Southwest (SBC) files this letter pursuant to Section 64.1120 of the Commission's Rules. This letter provides notification of the transfer of certain Arkansas, Oklahoma and Kansas local exchange subscribers of Comm South Companies, Inc. ("Comm South") to SBC.

Comm South was unable to continue providing its customers telecommunications service in the above-mentioned regions. To prevent disconnection of service for Comm South customers, SBC began providing Comm South customers local telephone service, for an interim period. SBC provided these customers notice that they must select an alternative provider of telecommunications service during this interim period or SBC will become their provider of choice. If no alternative provider is selected, the affected customers will become local exchange or local exchange and toll customers of SBC on April 13, 2006. SBC certifies that it has complied with the obligations specified in the notice and any other applicatory statutory and Commission requirements. Sample notification letters are attached hereto.
