On Wednesday, March 15, 2006, Lawrence Krevor, Geoff Stearn, James Goldstein, Betty Gerald, and Patty Tikkala of Sprint Nextel Corporation ("Sprint Nextel") and I met with David Furth and Michael Wilhelm of the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau and Geraldine Matise and Jamison Prime of the Office of Engineering and Technology to discuss the status of 800 MHz reconfiguration and the clearing of Broadcast Auxiliary Service ("BAS") facilities from the 1990-2025 MHz band.
