ORDER PRIOR TO PREHEARING CONFERENCE


A prehearing conference in this proceeding is scheduled to be held on April 20, 2006. See Order, FCC 06M-01, released March 9, 2006. The Presiding Judge deems it desirable to establish the following procedures:

A. By April 12, 2006, counsel for all the parties are directed to confer for the purpose of exploring a total or partial settlement of this proceeding, and establishing a proposed procedural schedule which will govern this proceeding. The proposed schedule shall include dates for the following: (i) Completion of all discovery; (ii) Post-discovery settlement conference at which decision-making personnel of each party (except the Enforcement Bureau) will be required to attend; (iii) Exchange of written direct case exhibits; (iv) Admissions session and notification of witnesses desired for cross-examination; and (v) Commencement of the hearing. Counsel are also directed to develop a proposed discovery plan including the subjects on which discovery may be needed, when discovery should be completed, and whether discovery should be conducted in phases or be limited to or focused upon particular issues.

B. By April 14, 2006, a Joint Report shall be filed fully apprising the Presiding Judge as to the results of the meeting described above. The report shall include a detailed outline of the discovery plan.
