On March 23, 2006, the undersigned, attorney for TerreStar Networks, Inc. ("TerreStar"), Jared Abbruzzese, Chairman of the Board of TerreStar, Robert Brumley, CEO of TerreStar, Alexandra Field, VP-Regulatory of TerreStar, and Amy Mehlman, of Mehlman Capitol Strategies, met with Donald Abelson, Chief, International Bureau, and Patricia Cooper of the Office of the Bureau Chief to update them on the progress that TerreStar has made in constructing its MSS system and focusing on homeland defense, public safety and rural broadband services.

The TerreStar representatives stated that 20 MHz of spectrum was essential to the provision of such services and that the Petitions for Reconsideration ("Petitions") filed in the above-referenced proceedings should be promptly dismissed so that MSS operators may proceed without delay with the financing and construction of their systems and the provision of much needed services to the public.
