Dear Ms. Dortch:

On behalf of AT&T Inc. (AT&T), Eric Einhorn, Brian Benison and the undersigned met with Tom Navin, Don Stockdale, Tom Buckley and Mary McManus of the Wireline Competition Bureau on March 29, 2006, to discuss the above-referenced petitions. We explained that all of the IP-in-the-Middle services at issue in these petitions are telecommunications services subject to access charges under the plain language of section 69.5 of the Commission's rules and the Commission's *IP-in-the-Middle Order*.<sup>1</sup> We urged the Commission to expeditiously issue an order granting the AT&T and Frontier petitions and denying the Vartec petition. All of the matters discussed during the meeting were consistent with AT&T's previous filings in this docket.
