On behalf of AT&T Inc. (AT&T), Bob Quinn, Jack Zinman, and I met with Dana Shaffer on March 30, 2006, about the above-referenced matters. At the meeting, we reiterated AT&T's request that the Commission adopt rules to advance universal service and establish regulatory neutrality for all prepaid calling card services. We also discussed AT&T's position on universal service contribution methodology reform. Finally, we discussed the need for comprehensive intercarrier compensation reform. All of the matters discussed during the meeting were consistent with AT&T's previous advocacy in the above referenced dockets.
