

**SUPPLEMENT TO REQUEST FOR A LIMITED WAIVER
OF UNITED STATES CELLULAR CORPORATION**

United States Cellular Corporation ("USCC"), by its undersigned counsel, hereby submits this Supplement to its Request for a Limited Waiver of the Commission's rule requiring that 95 percent of all handsets in use on its network be GPS-compliant by December 31, 2005. *See* 47 C.F.R. § 20.18(g)(1)(v). As a result of an aggressive marketing campaign designed to convince customers with noncompliant or unidentified handsets to upgrade and the use of a recently-discovered vendor database that allowed the Company to identify the GPS-capabilities of approximately 200,000 previously unidentified handsets, USCC's GPS-capable handset penetration is 91.48% as of March 31, 2006. This represents an increase of more than 6 percent from the Company's estimated 85 percent GPS-capable handset penetration as of December 31, 2005.
