WT Docket No. 03-66; Amendment of Parts 1, 21, 73, 74 and 101 of the Commission's Rules to Facilitate the Provision of Fixed and Mobile Broadband Access, Educational and Other Advanced Services in the 2150-2162 and 2500-2690 MHz Bands

Dear Ms. Dortch:

Yesterday, on behalf of the Catholic Television Network ("CTN") and the National ITFS Association ("NIA"), Monsignor Michael J. Dempsey, President of CTN; Todd Gray, legal counsel to NIA, and the undersigned, legal counsel to CTN, met with Commissioner Deborah Taylor Tate, Aaron Goldberger, and John Grant regarding the above-referenced proceeding.

Our presentation focused on the missions and constituencies of CTN and NIA, with particular emphasis their efforts to promote the educational use of Educational Broadband Service ("EBS") spectrum. With respect to the ongoing debate concerning EBS lease term limits, Mr. Gray expressed NIA's willingness to support a 25 year lease term limit subject to certain conditions. Monsignor Dempsey indicated that CTN is willing to support a maximum EBS lease term limit of up to 30 years if the Commission adopts a rule which provides EBS licensees with the ability to review their educational use requirements at periodic intervals so as to ensure that EBS spectrum is used efficiently and effectively for educational purposes.

Pursuant to Section 1.1206(b)(2) of the Commission's Rules, we are submitting this summary of the presentation by filing an electronic copy of this letter in the public record of the proceeding.
