On April 5, 2006, the following individuals met with FCC officials to discuss issues in the above referenced proceeding: David Donovan, Esq., president, MSTV; Victor Tawil, vice president, MSTV; Kevin Reed, Esq., Dow Lohnes and Albertson; Anne Lucey, Esq., CBS Corporation; Ken Howard, Esq., Baker & Hostetler, LLP; Peter Pappas, Esq., executive vice president, Pappas Telecasting Companies; John Griffith Johnson, Jr., Esq., Paul, Hastings, Janofsky & Walker, LLP; and Molly Pauker, Esq., vice president/legal affairs, Fox Television Stations. This delegation met with Commissioner Jonathan Adelstein and his media advisor Rudy Brioché. We also met with Dana Shaffer, legal advisor to Commissioner Deborah Taylor Tate.

We discussed the interference problems associated with QUALCOMM's plan to operate its MediaFLO service on channel 55. Specifically, we emphasized the need for a more accurate methodology for measuring interference from multiple transmitters. In this regard, we focused on MSTV's proposed methodology that was filed in the record regarding this proceeding on March 31, 2006. Copies of this filing were distributed.
