This is to inform you that, on April 6, 2006, Stacy Fuller and undersigned counsel on behalf of DIRECTV, Inc. ("DIRECTV") met with Jessica Rosenworcel, Legal Advisor to Commissioner Copps, to discuss DIRECTV's recent *ex parte* submissions in the above-captioned proceeding. In particular, DIRECTV discussed how confidential documents submitted by Comcast Corp. and Time Warner Cable Inc. demonstrate the anticompetitive implications of the proposed transactions, as confirmed by DIRECTV's analysis of their internal data. In addition, the Applicants have failed to substantiate the public interest benefits they claim will result from the transactions.

In addition, outside the presence of Ms. Fuller, undersigned counsel provided Ms. Rosenworcel with a copy of the *ex parte* letters filed by DIRECTV on April 3 and April 6 discussing Highly Confidential Information produced by the Applicants in this proceeding, and reviewed with her the contents of these and other confidential submissions filed over the last two months.
