On Thursday, April 6, 2006, Amy Tykeson, CEO of Bend Broadband, and I met with Jessica Rosenworcel, Senior Legal Advisor to Commissioner Michael J. Copps. Ms. Tykeson described her cable system in Bend, Oregon and issues peculiar to small systems such as hers. She also discussed her views on current issues such as à la carte programming offerings, “network neutrality” and her concern with the FCC rule prohibiting cable operators from providing set-top boxes with integrated security as of July 1, 2007. Those views reflected comments filed by NCTA in the above-referenced dockets.
