
## MOTION TO SUPPLEMENT PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION

Good Karma Broadcasting, LLC (“*Good Karma*”), by its attorneys, hereby requests leave to supplement its pending Petition for Reconsideration of the Audio Division’s Report and Order in the above-captioned proceeding. In the Report and Order, the Audio Division dismissed Good Karma’s Petition for Rulemaking to amend Section 73.202(b), the FM Table of Allotments, to reallocate Channel 263A from Columbus to Monona, Wisconsin (the “*Petition*”) because it relied upon Good Karma’s then ungranted application for a construction permit to change the community of license of WTTN(AM) from Watertown to Columbus, Wisconsin (FCC File No. BMJP-20050118AJT) (the “*WTTN Application*”) as a “backfill” to replace the prospective loss of the sole local service to Columbus. Good Karma sought reconsideration of the Report and Order on the grounds that it was inconsistent with prior Commission precedent, and the overall public interest.

The purpose of this supplement is to notify the Audio Division that the WTTN Application was granted on April 7, 2006.<sup>1</sup> Because the Petition no longer relies on an ungranted construction permit application as a “backfill” to replace the prospective loss of the sole local service to Columbus, the basis for the FCC’s dismissal of Good Karma’s Petition no longer exists. Good Karma therefore respectfully requests that the Audio Division reconsider its decision in the Report and Order and grant the Petition.
