
Re: *Ex parte* presentation in MM Docket No. 05-192 and MM Docket No. 92-264

Dear Ms. Dortch:

On April 19, 2006, Gene Kimmelman, Senior Vice President for Federal and International Affairs and Jeannine Kenney, Senior Policy Analyst, both of Consumers Union, met with Commissioner Michael Copps, and Legal Advisor, Jessica Rosenworcel, to reiterate Consumers Union's concerns and comments filed in MM Docket No. 92-264—Cable Horizontal and Vertical Ownership Limits and Attribution Rules; and MM Docket No. 05-192— Applications of Adelphia Communications Corporation, Comcast Corporation and Time Warner Cable Inc., For Authority to Assign and/or Transfer Control of Various Licenses. Consumers Union believes that all the issues it raised with respect to horizontal ownership limits, and appropriate remedies to deal with excessive horizontal concentration, are directly relevant to the Comcast-Time Warner transaction and should be considered by the Commission as it evaluates license transfers in this proceeding.
