Dear Madam Secretary:

AT&T Inc, on behalf of its affiliate, AT&T Texas files this letter pursuant to Section 64.1120 of the Commission's Rules. This letter provides notification of the transfer of certain Texas local exchange subscribers of IQC Communications ("IQC") to AT&T Texas ("AT&T").

IQC was unable to continue providing its customers telecommunications service in the above-mentioned region. To prevent disconnection of service for IQC customers, AT&T began providing IQC customers local telephone service, for an interim period. AT&T provided these customers notice that they must select an alternative provider of telecommunications service during this interim period or AT&T will become their provider of choice. If no alternative provider is selected, the affected customers will become local exchange or local exchange and toll customers of AT&T on May 22, 2006. AT&T certifies that it has complied with the obligations specified in the notice and any other applicatory statutory and Commission requirements. A sample notification letter is attached hereto.
