Dear Madam Secretary:

AT&T Inc, on behalf of its affiliate, AT&T Texas (AT&T) files this letter pursuant to Section 64.1120 of the Commission's Rules. This letter provides notification of the certain Texas local exchange subscribers of Superior Phone Company. ("Superior") to AT&T.

Superior was unable to continue providing its customers telecommunications service in the above-mentioned regions. To prevent disconnection of service for Superior customers, AT&T began providing Superior customers local telephone service, for an interim period. AT&T provided these customers notice that they must select an alternative provider of telecommunications service or their service will be disconnected. The affected customers will be disconnected from AT&T on April 20, 2006. AT&T certifies that it has complied with the obligations specified in the notice and any other applicable statutory and Commission requirements. Sample notification letters are attached hereto.

A copy of the notice and attachments sent to affected subscribers is attached hereto as Exhibit "A".


