I am writing this letter to express not only my displeasure in regards to the recent disruption of our internet service but my outrage as well. The cost to use my ISP going to skyrocket not only for normal use but as my daughter is taking a class via Illinois Virtual High School. It is my understanding that my ISP would be exempt from the problem because they had established the necessary CLEC agreements and filled out the required paperwork. It appears, though, that even with those agreements in place, the incumbent carriers still have the freedom to block the call.

The FCC needs to understand that their ruling has enabled the RBOCs to eliminate competition through a simple software upgrade. In some areas, dialing long distance is now the only option; in other areas, high-priced monopolies are the only option. The FCC has thusfar overlooked this side effect.

I hope this issue will be addressed immediately or at a minimum, the carriers instructed to restore the service until the matter is resolved.
