

I encourage the FCC to actually act on this NPRM.

The comment period officially ended 7 months ago.

They have no excuse for waiting.

The waiting is not doing *\*any\** good for the amateur radio community.

I support removal of the morse code test for all license classes.

1. The fact that you have to pass *\*two\** tests for the middle license class is absurd.

You only have to pass one for the entry license and one for the top license.

2. Morse code is the past of radio, not the future.

Testing on it hardly has any relation to 'advancing the radio art'.

If the FCC wants a mode-specific test that pushes the stated purposes of the amateur radio service, they need to have a digital modes / software defined radio theory element.
