On May 17, 2006, Jacquelynn Ruff and Leslie Owsley from Verizon, and Jim Talbot and I from AT&T met with Jim Ball, Breck Blalock, Jerry Duvall, Francis Gutierrez, David Krech, and Mark Uretsky of the International Bureau and Jim Lande of the Wireline Competition Bureau to discuss our joint positions in this docket.

We reviewed the status of the proceeding, and the importance of streamlining the current reporting rules as much as possible. We discussed how to ensure that the detailed implementation of these requirements in the final rules does not inadvertently undo any intended streamlining. We discussed several specific items, including the importance of preserving flexibility in reporting non-route specific revenues, maintaining a balanced approach in how the new reporting elements should be reported, and eliminating the CMRS resale reporting requirements.
