MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

RFD Communications, Inc. (“RFD”), by counsel, submits this Motion seeking a brief extension of the pleading schedule established for consideration of the Petition for Declaratory Ruling (“Petition”) filed by Farm Journal, Inc., which asks the Commission to find that RFD is not a qualified national educational programming supplier for purposes of the Direct Broadcast Satellite set-aside program. For the reasons set forth below, the public interest would be served by extending the time to file responses to the Petition through June 21, 2006, and to file replies through July 6, 2006.

In a recent meeting between RFD’s counsel and FCC personnel, Commission staff raised a number of questions regarding the nature of RFD’s service and the FCC’s jurisdiction in this matter. RFD believes that, with the benefit of this brief extension, it will be able to gather the facts needed to address fully the Petition and the issues posed by staff. Submission of one substantive response by RFD in this matter will promote administrative efficiency. Moreover, since the Commission has designated this matter as “permit-but-disclose,” all interested party

have the opportunity to advise the Commission of facts relevant to the Commission's consideration of this proceeding during its pendency. Counsel for Farm Journal, Inc. has been advised of this request.

Accordingly, it is respectfully requested that the Commission grant this Motion and permit responses to the Petition to be filed through June 21, 2006, and replies to be filed through July 6, 2006.
