Dear Madam Secretary:

AT&T Inc, on behalf of its affiliate, AT&T Illinois (AT&T) files this letter pursuant to Section 64.1120 of the Commission's Rules. This letter provides notification of the transfer of certain Illinois local exchange subscribers of WorldCom to AT&T.

WorldCom was unable to continue providing its customers telecommunications service in the AT&T region. To prevent disconnection of service for WorldCom customers, AT&T began providing WorldCom customers local telephone service, for an interim period. AT&T provided these customers notice that they must select an alternative provider of telecommunications service or their service will be disconnected. The affected customers will be disconnected from AT&T on June 20, 2006, unless they selected another provider. AT&T certifies that it has complied with the obligations specified in the notice and any other applicable statutory and Commission requirements. A sample notification letter is attached hereto.
