

Concerning Agenda Item 1.9 of WRC-2007, it is important that the US continue the FCC's efforts to promote the 2500-2690 MHz band for terrestrial wireless broadband use, and prevent satellite systems authorized by foreign governments from causing interference to domestic facilities. To advance this goal the US position at WRC-2007 must both call for the adoption of the hard Power Flux Density limits on satellites that are specified in Document WAC/101 and for the elimination of the MSS allocation in the 2500-2690 MHz band within Region 2.
