**Re: E911 Requirements for IP-Enabled Service Providers, WC Docket No. 05-196**

Dear Ms. Dortch:

On behalf of AT&T Inc. (AT&T), I am submitting this letter to update certain information that AT&T provided to the Commission on May 12, 2006, regarding the compliance of AT&T CallVantage® Service with the Commission's VoIP 911 rules.<sup>1</sup> Specifically, we informed the Commission that, due to a clerical error, a particular AT&T CallVantage subscriber that we thought had been transitioned to E911 service was, in fact, still receiving A911 service.<sup>2</sup> Because the subscriber was located in an area where neither AT&T nor our E911 vendor was able to provide her with E911 service, we informed the subscriber, pursuant to procedures described in our prior filings, that she would need to transition to an alternative service offering within approximately 30 days, and we would refund all amounts the subscriber paid for AT&T CallVantage service. The subscriber subsequently informed AT&T that she would port her AT&T CallVantage telephone number to Vonage. AT&T has since received a telephone number port away request for this subscriber as well as a port away order confirmation, and she is no longer a customer of AT&T CallVantage service.
