

Gill of McDermott Will & Emery met on May 30, 2006 with Christina Clearwater, Won Kim, Paul Murray, Nese Guendelsberger, and Matt Gerst of the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau to discuss SouthernLINC Wireless's position in the above referenced docket.
