and Delete Issues In The Hearing Designation Order filed by Respondent Entergy Arkansas, Inc. (“Entergy” or “EAI”) on May 4, 2006.

Complainants are mindful that the Commission’s rules generally limit Motions to Enlarge, Change and Delete Issues to three pleadings (motion, opposition and reply). 47 C.F.R. § 1.229(d); 47 C.F.R. § 1.294(c) & (d). Additional pleadings may be filed if specifically authorized or requested by the person who is to make the ruling. 47 C.F.R. § 1.294(d).


Good cause exists to grant this Motion. In its Reply, Entergy withdraws its initial request to change the text of Issue 4(c) and replaces it with completely different language. These changes fundamentally change the relief Entergy requests and, if granted, would fundamentally change the nature of the HDO.

Section 1.294(c) specifically limits Entergy’s Reply brief to matters raised in the Oppositions. By changing the fundamental nature of its relief in its Reply brief, Entergy has raised new issues beyond the scope of both the Motion and Oppositions.

Granting Complainants’ Motion would allow them to address Entergy’s changed position. Notions of fairness dictate that Complainants be able to explain why Entergy’s new, changed position, is prejudicial.
