On June 2, 2006, Commissioner Tate visited T-Mobile's Nashville Call Center and toured the facility. The T-Mobile employees accompanying Commissioner Tate on the tour were Sue Nokes, Tom Sugrue, Greg Perotto and Joe Morrone. During the course of the visit, the parties discussed the Advanced Wireless Services auction (Auction 66), truth-in-billing issues and early termination fees, the Universal Service Fund, matters involving customer proprietary network information, and emergency alert systems. The positions presented by T-Mobile were consistent with T-Mobile's comments and other filings submitted in the above-referenced dockets.
