On Tuesday, June 6, 2006, Lawrence Krevor, Vice President, Government Affairs – Spectrum, Sprint Nextel Corporation (“Sprint Nextel”), Marc Martin, Kirkpatrick & Lockhart Nicholson Graham LLP, counsel to Sprint Nextel, Susan Fox, Vice President, Government Relations, The Walt Disney Company (“Disney”), and I met with David Horowitz and Joel Kaufman of the Office of General Counsel to address the clearing of Broadcast Auxiliary Service (“BAS”) facilities from the 1990-2025 MHz band pursuant to 800 MHz band reconfiguration. In particular, we discussed the recent agreement of Sprint Nextel and the ABC Owned Television Stations Group, a unit of Disney, to a template Frequency Relocation Agreement for each ABC-owned station and a Group Reimbursement Agreement covering ABC’s station group relocation-related expenses.
