Pursuant to section 1.1206(b)(2) of the Commission's rules, we hereby submit this notice regarding an *ex parte* meeting in the above-referenced proceedings.

On Wednesday, June 7, 2006, Charles Benton and Gloria Tristani of the Benton Foundation met with Commissioner Jonathan S. Adelstein and his legal advisor, Rudy Brioche, to discuss the above-referenced dockets. Mr. Benton and Ms. Tristani argued that the Commission should not revisit the issue of must-carry for digital broadcasting until it first addressed the disclosure requirements and public interest obligations for digital broadcasters. They sought an NPRM on the public interest obligations and an order requiring meaningful disclosure.
