Dear Madam Secretary:

AT&T Inc, on behalf of its affiliate, AT&T Texas (AT&T) files this letter pursuant to Section 64.1120 of the Commission's Rules. This letter provides notification of the certain Texas and Missouri local exchange subscribers of Comm South Companies Inc. ("Comm South") to AT&T.

Comm South was unable to continue providing its customers telecommunications service in the above-mentioned regions. To prevent disconnection of service for Comm South customers, AT&T began providing Comm South customers local telephone service, for an interim period. AT&T provided these customers notice that they must select an alternative provider of telecommunications service or their service will be disconnected. The affected customers will be disconnected from AT&T on July 6, 2006. AT&T certifies that it has complied with the obligations specified in the notice and any other applicable statutory and Commission requirements. Sample notification letters are attached hereto.
