On June 13, 2006, Phillip Spector, Executive Vice President and General Counsel of Intelsat Holdings, Ltd., Susan Crandall, Assistant General Counsel of Intelsat Global Service Corporation, Bert Rein of Wiley Rein & Fielding LLP, Jennifer Hindin of Wiley Rein & Fielding LLP, Kalpak Gude, Vice President and Associate General Counsel of PanAmSat and Henry Goldberg of Goldberg Godles Wiener & Wright met with Commissioner Adelstein and Barry Ohlson, Senior Legal Advisor to Commissioner Adelstein.

Also on June 13, 2006, Phillip Spector, Susan Crandall, Kalpak Gude, Jennifer Hindin and Gregg Elias of Wiley Rein & Fielding LLP met with Bruce Gottlieb, Legal Advisor to Commissioner Copps.

During each of these meetings, the participants discussed the benefits of the proposed merger of Intelsat and PanAmSat, the status of the pending applications for transfer of control of PanAmSat's FCC licenses and other matters of record in the docket, including Intelsat's ownership and public service commitments. In particular, the participants discussed timing of FCC action in light of the decision announced by Intelsat on May 26, 2006 that the Department of Justice had closed its investigation without seeking to impose conditions or otherwise commenting on the proposed merger.
