On June 13, 2006, Christopher Libertelli, on behalf of Skype, Inc., Richard Whitt, of NetsEdge Consulting LLC, on behalf of Google Inc., Brent Thompson on behalf of IAC/InterActiveCorp, Emmett O'Keefe, on behalf of Amazon, Inc. and the undersigned attorney for Skype met with Scott Bergmann, Legal Advisor For Wireline Issues for Commissioner Jonathan S. Adelstein, to discuss the net neutrality policies and principles set forth in the Commission's *Broadband Policy Statement*, FCC 05-151. We suggested that a nondiscrimination principle was equally important to assuring an open Internet. During our conversation, we also discussed the possibility of conditioning any approval of the acquisition of cable systems and assets of Adelphia Communications Corp. by Time Warner Inc. and Comcast Corp. on adherence to such policies and principles.
