On June 14, 2006, Angela Campbell of the Institute for Public Representation and Andrew Jay Schwartzman of Media Access Project met with Commissioner Deborah Taylor Tate and her Legal Advisor Aaron Goldberger.

Ms. Campbell and Mr Schwartzman communicated the following points:

1. The public needs adequate notice of the Commission's intentions with respect to the broadcast ownership docket and the opportunity to participate through public hearings.
2. The Commission should allow adequate time for comments and reply comments in the broadcast ownership proceedings. They stressed the importance of the reply comment phase and the need for time to digest what will be a large number of voluminous comments.
