EchoStar Satellite L.L.C. ("EchoStar") hereby reports that on June 14, 2006, Charles Ergen and Ross Lieberman of EchoStar met with Commissioner McDowell and Christina Pauze. At the meeting, EchoStar reiterated arguments made in its December 23, 2005, submission to the Commission, EchoStar requested that the Commission impose conditions to ameliorate the harm that would otherwise result from the proposed acquisition of Adelphia by Comcast and Time Warner. In EchoStar's view, these conditions should include program access obligations that would effectively capture subtle forms of discrimination, and arbitration of program access disputes, including discovery.
