Dear Ms. Dortch:

Intelsat Holdings, Ltd., PanAmSat Licensee Corp. (“PanAmSat LC”), and PanAmSat H-2 Licensee Corp. (“PanAmSat H-2 LC”), by their attorneys, file this letter pursuant to Section 1.65 of the FCC’s rules<sup>1</sup> to update information concerning their pending applications, which were filed in the above-referenced docket, to transfer control of the FCC licenses and authorizations held by PanAmSat LC and PanAmSat H-2 LC (the “Transfer Applications”).

The Transfer Applications included requests by PanAmSat LC for authority, following the proposed transfer of control, to continue operating in accordance with the terms of five grants of special temporary authority (“STA”) that PanAmSat LC held at the time the Transfer Applications were filed (the “Original STAs”).<sup>2</sup> The parties hereby inform the Commission that, under separate cover, PanAmSat LC’s requests for continuing authority relating to four of the Original STAs have been withdrawn.<sup>3</sup> PanAmSat no longer needs continuing authority for these four Original STAs, each of which either has expired or covered operations pending action on a modification application that subsequently was granted. The Commission previously dismissed as moot the request for continuing

authority relating to the fifth of the Original STAs, based on the fact that the request concerned a space station (Galaxy 3R) that had reached the end of its useful life.<sup>4</sup>

The parties also hereby inform the Commission that, under separate cover, PanAmSat has filed two new requests for authority to continue operating under STAs following the proposed transfer of control. The two new requests concern STAs that recently were issued to PanAmSat LC<sup>5</sup> and consistent with the request made in the Transfer Applications are not subject to additional public notice.<sup>6</sup>
