Until recently, Southern Telcom Network, Inc. ("Southern Telcom Network") had been providing your local telephone service (dial tone) over the resold facilities of AT&T. As you may be aware, Southern Telcom Network is no longer able to provide your local telephone service.

But for the terms of the agreement governing Southern Telcom Network's service to you, once Southern Telcom Network's account with AT&T was disconnected, your local telephone service would have been disconnected, too. To prevent your service from being disconnected without notice to you, AT&T began providing local telephone service to you on June 16, 2006 for a limited transition period. The last day of this limited transition period will be July 17, 2006.

Important: You have a choice in selecting the local telephone service provider you want to provide service to you. To continue to receive service after July 17, 2006, you must arrange for local telephone service with one of the local telephone service providers in your area. You must contact the local telephone service provider you prefer to arrange for service before July 17, 2006. Contact numbers for local telephone service providers in your area are available in your local telephone directory. You must make arrangements with a provider to actually begin providing you service *before* July 17, 2006 to avoid interruption of your service.

AT&T records indicate that as of June 16, 2006, you have not yet made your selection of a local telephone service provider. There is approximately one month before the limited transition period ends and your service will be disconnected. AT&T can not continue to provide service to you under the limited transition arrangement after July 17, 2006. You must make arrangements with a provider before July 17, 2006 to avoid interruption of your local telephone service.

Should you wish to continue receiving AT&T service after July 17, 2006, please call our business office before that date. The telephone number for the AT&T business office in your area is available in your AT&T Southwest White Pages directory.

Remember, you must have replacement service up and running before July 17, 2006. If you fail to have replacement service up and running before July 17, 2006 you may not be able to keep the same telephone number for use with replacement service established after the limited transition service has been disconnected.

If you have changed your local telephone service provider since June 16, 2006, please disregard this letter. **If you have any questions regarding this letter please call 1-800-667-1086 .**

Act now to prevent a disruption in your telephone service.
