On Behalf of AT&T Inc. ("AT&T"), Tom Hughes, Jim Smith, and Jim Lamoureux met with Leslie Marx and Sherille Ismail of the Office of Strategic Planning and Policy Analysis on June 15, 2006. At the meeting, AT&T urged the Commission to adopt a streamlined competitive franchising process pursuant to its authority to adopt rules implementing Section 621(a) of the Act. Consistent with its previously filed comments, AT&T also urged the Commission to establish that buildout requirements imposed as conditions of entry on competitive franchisees are unreasonable barriers to entry. AT&T also provided an overview of its Project Lightspeed and its IPTV platform. The attached presentation was used as the basis of the meeting.
