On June 14, 2006, Harold Feld and Paige Gold of Media Access Project and Alex Nogales, President of National Hispanic Media Coalition (NHMC) met with Leslie Marx, FCC Chief Economist. With reference to the above captioned proceeding, Mr. Nogales stated that a la carte would have a devastating effect on minority programming. The comments he made were substantially similar to those stated in the meeting with Commissioner Tate on June 13, 2006. Mr. Feld stressed that MAP has no position on a la carte.
