Dear Ms. Dortch:

On June 19, 2006, the undersigned (“Ms. Desai”) and Jaime Porter, both of Media Access Project (“MAP”), met with Rudy Brioché, Legal Advisor for Media Issues to Commissioner Jonathan Adelstein, at the offices of the Federal Communications Commission. At this meeting, Ms. Desai and Mr. Brioché discussed the status of the Table of Allotments and LPFM proceedings.

Additionally, in regards to the LPFM proceeding, Ms. Desai emphasized that the main issues of concern to MAP are protecting LPFM stations from encroachment by full power stations and treating LPFM applications as primary to translators in certain instances. In regards to the Table of Allotments proceeding, Ms. Desai argued that streamlining the allotment process may not be necessary and retaining a comment period is vital to ensuring that community input is received. Ms. Desai noted that LPFM station owners rely on the Table in order to anticipate whether full power stations will be seeking licenses that could encroach on LPFM stations. Thus, allowing changes to the Table by minor modification would be detrimental to LPFM stations.
