ORDER

On June 5, 2006, Gulf Power filed Notice of Cause to Maintain Confidentiality Over Certain Trial Exhibits. Gulf Power seeks confidential protection for **Gulf Power Exh. 11** (Southern Company Overhead Distribution Construction Manual) (“Manual”); and **Complainants’ Exh. 5** (Excerpts of Manual).

Complainants must file and serve by **10:00 a.m., June 8, 2006**, any Objection. The Enforcement Bureau may file by **10:00 a.m., June 8, 2006**, any Comment. Gulf Power may file a Reply by **4:00 p.m., June 9, 2006**.¹

¹ See *Memorandum Opinion and Order* FCC 06M-14, released May 26, 2006 (“*MO&O*”) (Gulf Power to show cause by June 5). The *MO&O* set June 12 for Objection/Comment and June 16 for Reply. Those dates were set in anticipation of the possibility of a lengthy show cause with extensive document analysis and argument. Gulf Power’s Notice of Cause is limited to a lengthy Manual which is technical in content but fairly self-explanatory as to primary purpose. Therefore, a revised and substantially shortened pleading cycle is appropriate. See 47 C.F.R. § 1.294.

The parties also should consider agreeing to the withdrawal from evidence of the Manual (Gulf Power Exh. 11) and rely on the minimalized Manual excerpts in Complainants' Exh. 5 which should not need confidential treatment since the information is so limited and admittedly not commercially sensitive.
