Dear Ms. Dortch:

On behalf of Cedar Rapids Television Company (“CRTC”), the licensee of digital television station KCRG-DT, Cedar Rapids, Iowa, we hereby notify and confirm to the Commission that the station is operating with *licensed* digital television facilities that satisfy the FCC’s requirements for compliance with the July 1, 2006 replication/maximization interference protection deadline.

Station KCRG-DT currently operates on out-of-core digital channel 52. The station has been given a tentative digital channel designation on channel 9, its current analog channel. Pursuant to paragraph 78 of the FCC’s *Second DTV Periodic Review Report and Order*, by July 1, 2006, the station must be operating such that it serves at least 80% of the number of viewers served by the 1997 facility on which its replication coverage was based.

The DTV facilities specified in KCRG-DT’s license, FCC File No. BLCDT-20040317ACD, meet the 80% criteria. Accordingly, CRTC respectfully requests that the Commission continue to afford full interference protection to KCRG-DT’s replication contour as certified in its FCC Form 381, FCC File No. BCERCT-20041104AAA.
