Request for Waiver of the Replication/Maximization Interference
Protection Deadline**

Dear Ms. Dortch

On behalf of Bet-Nahrain, Inc., licensee of noncommercial educational Television Broadcast Station KBSV, Ceres, California (the "Applicant"), it is requested, pursuant to Public Notice, DA-06-1255 (DTV Channel Election Issues), released June 14, 2006, that the Applicant be granted a waiver of the July 1, 2006 replication/maximization interference protection deadline established by the Commission in Paragraph 78 of the Second DTV Periodic Review Report and Order, 19 FCC Rcd 18279 (2004). In support of such waiver request the following is set forth.

On December 15, 2004, the Applicant was granted a construction permit (File No. BMPEDT-20041203AAA) to locate its digital facilities on an existing antenna tower. The Applicant had an oral agreement with the tower owner for use of the existing tower, but over the succeeding months negotiations over a written lease resulted in the tower owner withdrawing its permission to use the tower in December 2005, a circumstance clearly beyond the control of the Applicant.

With no permanent digital transmission site, the Applicant, on January 30, 2006, filed a request for STA (File No. BDSTA-20060130AQP) to operate with temporary DTV facilities from its analog transmission site; such STA was granted on February 14, 2006 and the Applicant initiated DTV operations with such temporary facilities on April 29, 2006.



Over the past few months, the Applicant has also negotiated for a new DTV transmission site and has received permission from the site owner to specify such alternative site for its DTV facilities; accordingly, on June 22, 2006, Applicant filed an application (File No. BMPEDT-20060622ABE) to modify its DTV construction permit. Applicant anticipates being able to fully construct, place in operation and file a covering license application for its regularly authorized DTV facilities within 30-45 days of its modification request being granted.

In an excess of caution, Applicant is seeking a six month waiver of the July 1, 2006 compliance date with the expectation that its regularly authorized DTV facilities will be expeditiously implemented upon grant and be operational well before January 1, 2007. Applicant submits that circumstances beyond its control have necessitated this waiver request and that the Applicant has demonstrated good cause for grant of a waiver of the July 1, 2006 compliance deadline.
