On June 26, 2006 Bob Udell of Consolidated, Eric Einhorn of AT&T and Lisa Zaina of ITTA met with Michelle Carey of Chairman Martin's office to discuss the phantom traffic solutions set out in the "Missoula Plan", which was developed by an industry group under the auspices of the NARUC Intercarrier Compensation Taskforce.

The parties described the Missoula Plan's phantom traffic solution, its development, and its inclusion in the comprehensive intercarrier compensation reform proposal. Over the past several years, the Commission has received various proposals to address phantom traffic and intercarrier compensation reform.

In the interest of resolving these issues, and in the spirit of consensus and compromise, the Plan supporters have bridged differences in their own prior positions and have developed the Missoula Plan, which provides for comprehensive intercarrier compensation reform that includes robust interim and long term solutions to phantom traffic. We look forward to working with the Commission as it considers the entire Missoula Plan, including its phantom traffic provisions, once it is filed.
