


As certified in its Form 381 filing, WUNC-DT intends to operate its post-transition DTV station based on its replication facility (1000 kW and 469 meters HAAT). WUNC-DT is presently operating its DTV facility pursuant to its DTV license in FCC File No. BLEDT-20020102AAW (893.2 kW and 448 meters HAAT), and has received a tentative DTV channel designation on a channel that is not its current DTV channel (Channel 25).

As UNC believes that WUNC-DT's current operation covers at least 80 percent of the number of viewers predicted to be served by its replication facility, UNC has complied with the FCC's DTV replication deadline.
