Dear Ms. Dortch:

On behalf of Forum Communications Company ("Forum"), the permittee of digital television ("DTV") station WDAY-DT, Fargo, North Dakota (Facility Id. # 22129), we hereby advise the Commission that WDAY-DT is not subject to the July 1, 2006 interference protection deadline.

Forum holds an outstanding construction permit for WDAY-DT, FCC File No. BMPCDT-20060330AKD, that expires after July 1, 2006. Accordingly, pursuant to paragraph 84 of the *Second Periodic Review Report and Order*, WDAY-DT must satisfy its replication/maximization requirements by December 23, 2006, the expiration date specified in its construction permit, rather than July 1, 2006. *Second Periodic Review of the Commission's Rules and Regulations Concerning the Transition to Digital Television*, MB Docket No. 03-15, FCC 04-192, ¶ 84 (rel. Sept. 7, 2004).

Concurrently with this filing, Forum is requesting an extension of WDAY-DT's special temporary authority to operate at reduced power while it continues to construct the facilities specified in WDAY-DT's construction permit. See FCC File No. BDSTA-20031027ABI.
