
Certification of Implementation

1. My name is Priscilla Hill-Ardoin. My title is Senior Vice President-Regulatory Compliance & Chief Privacy Officer. I am employed by AT&T Services, Inc. and am authorized to provide this certification on behalf of AT&T Inc. ("AT&T") with regard to the above-referenced matter.

2. In accordance with the condition set forth in the SBC/AT&T Merger Order, I hereby certify that, to the best of my knowledge, information and belief, on June 13, 2006, AT&T Inc. introduced an ADSL service offering in each of the thirteen in-region states which does not require customers to also purchase circuit switched voice grade telephone service. As of June 13, 2006, the service was offered, in each of AT&T's thirteen in-region states, to at least eighty percent of the premises in AT&T's in-region service territories that are capable of receiving AT&T ADSL service in each of those states. Accordingly, the "implementation date" for the condition in each of AT&T's thirteen in-region states was June 13, 2006.

3. I declare under penalty of perjury that the foregoing is true and correct.
