Dear Ms. Dortch:

On June 30, 2006, Harold Feld and Jessica J. Gonzalez of Media Access Project (“MAP”) met with Angela E. Giancarlo, Commissioner Robert McDowell’s Wireless Advisor.

Mr. Feld reiterated the arguments on the Continental *Petition*, Docket Number 05-247, made in previous filings. Specifically, grant of Continental’s *Petition* is necessary to establish access for competing broadband providers. If the Commission rejects the *Petition*, the restrictions should be narrowly limited to rest upon public safety needs.

In regard to Docket Number 04-186, Mr. Feld emphasized the importance of opening the white spaces to unlicensed use.

Mr. Feld also restated that the 3650-3700 MHz *Petitions for Reconsideration*, Docket Number 04-151, should be rejected expeditiously for reasons discussed in previous filings.
