Dear Ms. Dortch:

On behalf of KENS-TV, Inc., the permittee of digital television station KENS-DT, San Antonio, Texas, we hereby supplement KENS-TV, Inc.'s request for waiver of the Commission's July 1, 2005 DTV replication/maximization interference protection deadline. On June 30, 2005, KENS-TV, Inc. submitted a request for waiver of the deadline because of the pendency of an application to modify KENS-DT's construction permit. That application was just granted on June 26, 2006. *See* FCC File No. BMPCDT-20050627ABY.

By this letter, KENS-TV, Inc. notifies the Commission that on June 29, 2006, the station commenced full power operations with the facilities specified in its modified DTV construction permit, and today filed an application on FCC Form 302-DT for a license to cover the permit. *See* FCC File No. BLCDDT-20060703ACB. Accordingly, further waiver of the July 1, 2005 deadline is unnecessary.
