Dear Ms. Dortch:

Agape Church, Inc. (“Agape”) is the licensee of television satellite station KVTJ, Jonesboro, Arkansas, which operates on NTSC channel 48 and has been assigned DTV channel 49. By letter dated February 9, 2005, Agape notified the FCC of its intention to “flash-cut” KVTJ from analog to digital transmission on its channel 48 allotment by the end of the digital television transition period, and surrender its channel 49 DTV allotment. *See also* FCC File No. BFRECT- 20050208AEG. Pursuant to the Commission’s *Report and Order*, FCC 04-192 at ¶104, MB Docket No. 03-15 (rel. Sept. 7, 2004), a satellite station that elects the “flash-cut” option will be treated as if it met the applicable replication/maximization build-out requirement. As a result, KVTJ is not subject to the Commission’s July 1, 2006 “use-or-lose” deadline.
