Dear Ms. Dortch:

On July 5, 2006, Susan Ness, a member of Adelphia Communications Corp.'s ("Adelphia") Board of Directors, participated in a telephone conversation with Commissioner Jonathan Adelstein regarding the above-captioned proceeding. The discussion focused on the status of Adelphia's bankruptcy process. Ms. Ness described the complexities of the bankruptcy. She noted that the proposed transactions with Comcast Corporation and Time Warner Inc., which will enable Adelphia to emerge from bankruptcy, provide many public interest benefits, including the accelerated rollout of advanced services for consumers in areas currently served by Adelphia, the repayment of Adelphia's innocent investors, and much needed certainty for Adelphia's employees and the local communities in which Adelphia operates. Ms. Ness also stressed that the Commission should act expeditiously to approve the transactions so that the parties may close by the July 31, 2006 deadline established in the deal documents.
