Subject: legal cost of KALW license challenge

Jackie:

Nicole passed onto me your request re: the legal costs of the challenge to our broadcast license.

* The license challenge by Golden Gate Public Radio was made in the fall of 1997.

* This weekend I reviewed the invoices from our Washington DC-based legal representative, Ernest Sanchez, dating from late 1997 to present which details all the legal matters he worked on during that period.

* The sum that I came up with from this analysis of the invoices is \$83,914 that the District has so far paid to defend itself from GGPR.

This amount may be off either way by maybe a \$1000 or so. When reviewing the charges listed on invoices some line items are not obvious from the description (e.g. "Review and edit Report to Licensee") if they necessarily related to work on the license challenge or other matters unrelated to the license challenge that were performed by Mr. Sanchez. In these cases I used my best judgement by reviewing other line item descriptions during that time to determine if they were likely to be related to the license challenge.

Please let me know if you need any further details regarding this matter.
